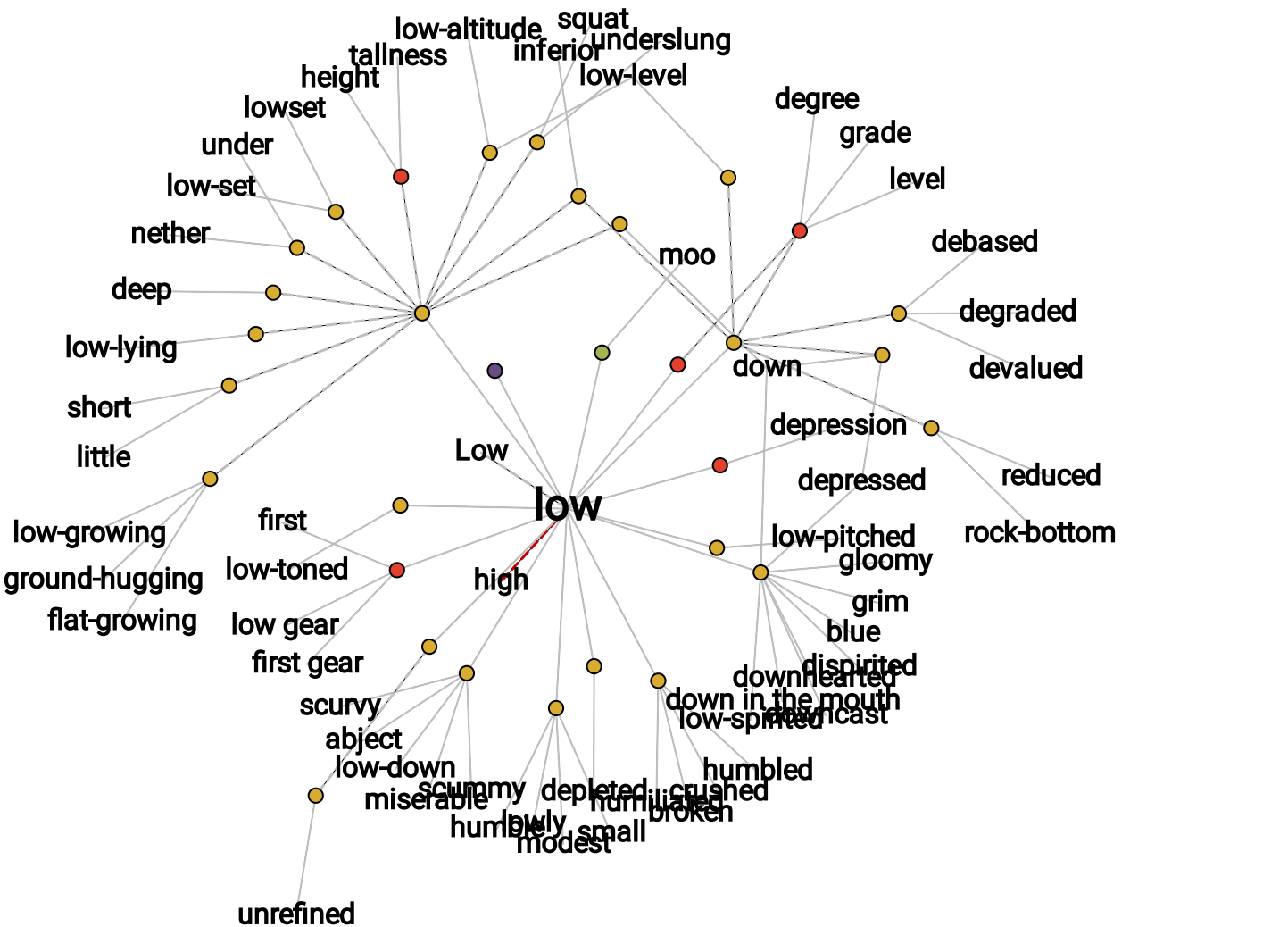


low

- low, depression

an air mass of lower pressure; often brings precipitation

"a low moved in over night bringing sleet and snow"

- low

a low level or position or degree

"the stock market fell to a new low"

- low, first, low gear, first gear

the lowest forward gear ratio in the gear box of a motor vehicle; used to start a car moving

ADJECTIVES

less than normal in degree or intensity or amount

"low prices"

"the reservoir is low"

- **low**

literal meanings; being at or having a relatively small elevation or upward extension

"low ceilings"

"low clouds"

"low hills"

"the sun is low"

"low furniture"

"a low bow"

- **low, low-toned**

very low in volume

"a low murmur"

"the low-toned murmur of the surf"

- **low**

unrefined in character

"low comedy"

- **low, low-pitched**

used of sounds and voices; low in pitch or frequency

- **low, scurvy, abject, low-down, miserable, scummy**

of the most contemptible kind

"abject cowardice"

"a low stunt to pull"

"a low-down sneak"

"his miserable treatment of his family"

"You miserable skunk!"

"a scummy rabble"

"a scurvy trick"

- **low, humble, lowly, modest, small**

low or inferior in station or quality

"a humble cottage"

"a lowly parish priest"

"a modest man of the people"

"small beginnings"

- **low, depleted**

no longer sufficient

"supplies are low"

"our funds are depleted"

- **low, humiliated, broken, crushed, humbled**

subdued or brought low in condition or status

"brought low"

"a broken man"

"his broken spirit"

- **low, downhearted, low-spirited, downcast, down in the mouth, down, dispirited, depressed, blue, grim, gloomy**

filled with melancholy and despondency

"gloomy at the thought of what he had to face"

"gloomy predictions"

"a gloomy silence"

"took a grim view of the economy"

"the darkening mood"

"lonely and blue in a strange city"

"depressed by the loss of his job"

"a dispirited and resigned expression on her face"

"downcast after his defeat"

"feeling discouraged and downhearted"

VERBS

- **low, moo**

make a low noise, characteristic of bovines

ADVERBS

- **low**

in a low position; near the ground

"the branches hung low"
